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<sup>1</sup> After thorough discussion, several members of the Working Group favoured an evaluation of the evidence of carcinogenicity in experimental animals as *sufficient*. This view emphasizes the dose-related induction of hepatoblastomas in male and female mice, because hepatoblastoma is a rare neoplasm with a low spontaneous incidence in mice, especially in females. However, the majority of the Working Group considered the evidence to be *limited* for the reasons discussed in Section 5.3.

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
